Note: Participants must be **aged 10 years or above** by 26th August 2010. Spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

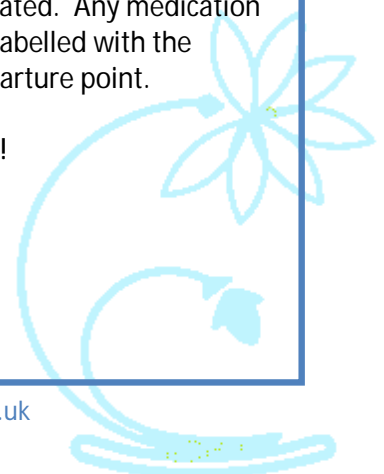

Items to bring

Sleeping bag, pillowcase, camping mat and blanket
2 pairs of Shishukunj uniform
1 warm sweater or jumper
4 pairs of socks
Raincoat/waterproof jacket, preferably hooded
1 pair of extra sports shoes
Tracksuit bottoms
Night clothing
Appropriate underclothing
Small towel, soap
Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb
Plate, bowl, spoon, mug/plastic glass (not steel)
Rope, carrier bags
Torch and batteries
Notebook and pencil/pen

All items must be named and except the sleeping bag, should fit within one small/medium sports bag. Baalako must be able to carry their own luggage.

Forbidden Items

Sweets/chocolates/chewing gum and any other food
Playing cards
Audio devices
Money
Aerosol cans
